Dr. Sienko is an Associate Investigator at The Shriners Hospital for Children in Portland, Oregon. Prior to that she was the manager of the Motion Analysis Laboratory at Children's Memorial Hospital in Chicago, IL. Dr. Sienko's research interests focus on the utilization of gait analysis, energy efficiency, functional assessments, and parent-report outcome tools to examine the efficacy of treatment interventions provided to children with childhood onset disabilities. Her dissertation focused on the factors that impact the health and well-being of young adults with cerebral palsy as they transition from the pediatric to adult health care system.
