AACPDM invites your submission in one or more of the following categories:

Scientific Paper (Free Paper) and Poster Presentations: You may choose to designate your scientific abstracts for oral or poster presentation. All accepted abstracts will be published in a supplement to the *Developmental Medicine and Child Neurology Journal*.

Demonstration Posters: These provide an opportunity to present new ideas, instruments (diagnostic and outcome tools), techniques and technologies, pilot work, interesting service delivery models, and other areas pertaining to the care of children with developmental disabilities. These abstracts are not published in the *Developmental Medicine and Child Neurology Journal*.

Instructional Course Lectures: These are focused educational courses, which may be didactic and/or interactive, presented by one or more individuals or groups.

Multimedia Presentations: Audio/Visual presentations of up to 30 minutes are to be submitted on CD-ROMS and/or DVD. Selected submissions will be presented at the 2009 meeting. All selected abstracts will be published in a supplement to the *Developmental Medicine and Child Neurology Journal*.
