## AACPDM Student Scholarship Information

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The Academy seeks applicants who are full-time students or trainees to apply for this scholarship. Scholarship applicants must be AACPDM members or [applicants](#), and must have submitted an abstract to the Annual Meeting. Scholarship applicants are not required to be the first author on the abstract. Preference will be given to scholarship applicants whose abstracts have been accepted.

Student Scholarship recipients receive:

- Complimentary registration to the Annual Meeting
- Complimentary Instructional Courses
- Valuable networking opportunities
- Opportunity to learn from multi-disciplinary experts in the field of childhood-onset disabilities
- Reimbursement of travel, hotel and food expenses up to \$1000 (maximum awarded).

### **Application**

Applications for the Student Scholarship are accepted online only. You will need to be a member, or apply for membership, *before you are able to access the form*. Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Be enrolled in a full-time degree program or be medical trainees (medical students, residents or fellows).
- Be an author on an abstract submitted to the 2017 Annual Meeting.
- Have [applied for AACPDM membership](#) or already be an AACPDM member.

As part of the online application process, you will be required to upload the following documents. Please have them ready to upload before you begin your application.

- A brief statement (1-2 paragraphs) outlining why you wish to have an AACPDM Scholarship
- A letter of support from your Program Chief, Clinical Head or authorized official indicating that you are in a good standing with the program
- A (brief) CV – *no more than two pages*
- A copy of your submitted abstract
