Announcing a new Editor in Chief

Mac Keith Press is very pleased to announce that, at the end of the recent recruitment process, Professor Bernard Dan, currently the Editor of DMCN (he took over from Dr Hilary Hart) will become Editor in Chief when Dr Peter Baxter steps down from the post in October 2015. Professor Dan is an internationally distinguished paediatric neurologist and he will be working closely with Dr Baxter over the next six months to ensure a smooth transition for the editorial team.

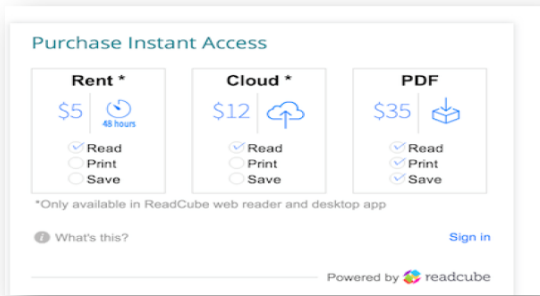

New features:

In order to give readers more flexible access to new papers, the Journal has recently been made available at a much lower price per paper, with more flexible viewing options:

Readcube

In October 2014 we moved to our Pay per View Service through Readcube with the provision of more flexible, attractively priced options for readers to rent/purchase PDFs from ReadCube. Since November across all Wiley titles the number of PPV article sales has increased versus monthly averages pre-ReadCube. We hope to see a positive effect for *DMCN* in 2015.



Our policy of making papers free to view after 12 months remains in place, so this charge is only for papers under a year old.
